## 1. How much does it cost?

Our basic rate is \$315.00 which includes 90 minutes of time for 15 children. Each additional participant after the initial 15 incurs a flat \$20.00 fee (inclusive of additional t-shirts and sport-bags). Additional time may be purchased at the rate of \$75.00 per 30-minute increment. Included in this price are two CATZ coaches, a customized Completely Active™ program, the use of our foyer area plus table & chair setup for cake or any other food you wish to provide. We can integrate any music or video you wish to provide through our media system. We will make every effort to accommodate any special requests. For safety reasons, we cannot allow confetti, piñatas or alcoholic beverages. Please note that if the number of participants in your party exceeds 24 an additional coach is mandatory and the appropriate fees will be applied. The additional coach fee is \$100.00 and allows for up to 36 participants. Also included are a CATZ T-shirt and sport-bag for every participant & passes for return visits to CATZ.

## 2. When do you run your Birthday parties?

Our most popular day is Sunday with a window of 11:00am - 4:00pm. Parties may be scheduled on other days based on the existing schedule at CATZ. Please call 626-533-5879 for specific time availability.
